


**Term 1

FULL TERMS

This year our classes will run for the full term, rather than 9 week terms. This will reduce confusion over start and end dates, and allow our members to maximise their training time. NEW UNIFORM!!

After reviewing the practicality of our recreational uniform we have re-developed it to a unisex sleeveless unitard which will provide a better fit, be cooler in the warmer weather, and eliminate the need to add pants. There is also the option of a unisex singlet top, which is the same as the unitard but stops at the waist and gymnasts can wear their own plain black pants or leggings with it. A plain black or lime green long sleeve top can be worn under both options during winter if desired. Both the unitard and singlet top are unisex for boys and girls, providing more flexibility for parents. These are available to order now from our website.

Members are very welcome to continue wearing their existing uniform until they need to purchase a new one.

KINDYGYM 4+

Lets ensure all our members stay safe



PARKING

Please park on the front carparks or roadside rather than down the shared driveway. The back parking spaces are for other businesses.

WATER

All gymnasts should be bringing their own water bottle to class. There are cubby holes to put them in and coaches will always encourage them to take a drink break.

SICKNESS

Please do not bring your child to class if they are unwell.

GYM FLOOR

For safety reasons we ask that parents and caregivers do not enter the Gym Floor area (except for preschool classes). While you are welcome to stay and watch from the spectator viewing area by the cubbies or the mezzanine floor, it is not a requirement for ages 5+ classes.

COACH CONTACT

If you need to talk to a coach please do it before or after class. Attempting to talk to coaches during class is a distraction and for safety reasons coaches need to remain focused on the gymnasts.

FEES

Term fees are due by the end of the first week of class. If fees are not paid by the end of the second week and you have not made alternative arrangements with us, your child may be asked to stand down for the session.
